

GGPWCF, INC., ANNUAL AWARDS POLICY
(est. 1/30/59; revised 1/27/96; revised 8/1/15)

Member-owned Corgis residing WITH club member are eligible to receive awards for finishing their Championships, winning a Group, Best in Show, or Specialty Best of Breed, and/or earning an Obedience, Rally, Agility, Tracking, Herding Title, Therapy Dog certification or Highest Scoring Dog in Trial.

CLARIFICATION OF POLICY (3/6/59; revised 12/14/85, 7/15/89)

Awards to be offered for members in USA or Canada, showing in USA. New members to receive awards for titles, degrees, and wins dated after their acceptance as members. Only one award will be given for a dog winning multiple Best in Show, Group 1, or High in Trial Awards.

AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED BY MEMBER (est. 9/16/66; revised 12/14/85)

An awards application shall be sent to all members and must be returned to the Awards Chair by stated deadline.

BEST PUPPY AWARD (revised 1/1/70, 7/15/89)

An award is offered for the puppy earning the highest number of points based on the following schedule. All wins to be from regular classes during the puppy's 6-12 month period, with award being claimed for the year in which the puppy becomes 12 months of age. The owner is to select the BEST SIX (6) ALL-BREED shows from which to claim awards. These points may then be added to specialty show wins without consideration for the number of specialty shows. Claim must specify name, date, and win of all shows where points are being counted. Only shows held in USA will be counted. (Use back of application form or separate sheet.)

ALL--BREED SHOWS with competition

(maximum of 6 shows; points are NOT cumulative)

FIRST PLACE	1 POINT
RESERVE WINNERS	2 POINTS
WINNERS	3 POINTS
BEST OF WINNERS	4 POINTS
BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX	4 POINTS
BEST OF BREED	6 POINTS

ADDITIONAL POINTS

For Group wins and Best in Show, add bonus pts as follows:

BEST IN SHOW	20 POINTS
GROUP FIRST	10 POINTS
GROUP SECOND	6 POINTS
GROUP THIRD	4 POINTS
GROUP FOURTH	2 POINTS

SPECIALTY SHOWS with competition

(no limit on number of shows; points are NOT cumulative)

FIRST PLACE	4 POINTS
RESERVE WINNERS	5 POINTS
WINNERS	6 POINTS
BEST OF WINNERS	8 POINTS
BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX	8 POINTS
BEST OF BREED	16 POINTS
BONUS -- BEST PUPPY	4 POINTS

STUD DOG AND BROOD BITCH AWARDS (est. 10/27/61; revised 7/15/89)

Award shall be presented to a member who owns an outstanding stud dog or brood bitch. May be claimed by a member when the dog/bitch no longer resides with, but is still owned by, the member. Awards to be presented for DOGS WHO HAVE Sired FIVE (5) OR MORE CHAMPIONS and for DAMS OF THREE (3) OR MORE CHAMPIONS. American, Canadian, and English championships shall count, but individual offspring finishing in more than one country shall count as only one champion. Due to the nature of this award, any members submitting a claim shall provide the name of the stud dog or brood bitch PLUS a list of the registered names of all champion progeny.

ADVANCED STUD DOG AND BROOD BITCH AWARDS (est. 5/9/75; revised 12/14/85)

For each increment of five (5) champion get for the stud dog or three (3) champion get for the brood bitch and in the year in which the fifth (stud dog) or third (brood bitch) champion completes his/her title.

SPECIALTY BEST OF BREED (*est. 4/25/64*)

Given to a Corgi winning BEST OF BREED at a separate Specialty Show.

BREEDER AWARD (*est. 12/14/85; revised 7/15/89*)

May be claimed by the breeder of any dog completing a title, but only one award shall be given for completion of obedience titles. Breeder may NOT be the registered owner of the dog.

SPECIAL OBEDIENCE AND CONFORMATION AWARDS

MARGARET DOWNING ACHIEVEMENT AWARD (*est. 1989*) – Offered by GGPWCF for the Highest Combined First Three Legs made by a member-owned Corgi while earning the CD, CDX or UD degree. First two scores may be counted without respect to the year they are earned, but the final score must be earned during the current awards year. Claim must list score and date of each show. No score shall count after the third leg has been earned.

CH WESTCOR BLITHE CD MEMORIAL AWARD (*Bred-by-Exhibitor award est. 1/27/68*) – Offered by Frank and Dorothy Westerlund to the GGPWCF member whose dog finished its championship with all points gained from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class. Claim must list all dates and shows where points were earned. Dog or bitch must still be owned by club member claiming award.

GGPWCF VERSATILE CORGI AWARDS (*est. 1/27/96*) – Two (2) points for each AKC performance events title and one (1) point for the CGC title and for each service dog certification. Claims must specify name and date of all shows where titles were earned.

VERSATILE CORGI AWARD – A dog must earn nine (9) points with a minimum of four (4) points to be earned in each of two (2) AKC performance areas. Alternately, a dog with at least four (4) points in one performance area and two (2) points in two (2) additional performance areas would qualify if it had earned nine (9) points.

VERSATILE CORGI EXCELLENT AWARD – A dog must earn a minimum of thirteen (13) points among three (3) or more performance areas, including three (3) titles in one area, a second area with two (2) titles, plus an AKC title in another. Alternately, thirteen (13) points with two titles (4 points) in each of three (3) AKC performance areas. The dog would thus need to earn at least two (2) new titles to progress to excellent award.
