I want to thank the committee for inviting me to judge the Golden Gate Pembroke Welsh Corgi Fanciers 49th specialty at the Los Gatos Lodge, and the great hospitality shown to my traveling companions and me. It was our first visit to California, and I was much honored to be given the opportunity to judge your dogs. The Lodge was a perfect spot for the show and even though dogs and exhibitors thought the weather was hotter than necessary, there were lots of places to find shade, and certainly much better than the reports from home where the rest of the family celebrated Norway's liberation day with snow!!!

We were met at the airport by your president Jackie Peterson, and she was absolutely marvelous company both before and after the show. I hope the club knows what a wonderful job she does with your visiting guests, and I am sure she does also with the club as such. We can only say, thank you Jackie, we will never forget you. I really like judging corgis in your country. I have had the fortune to judge in many parts of the world, also corgis, and I dare say that nowhere have I found the depth of quality higher than in the USA these days. The Americans are known to Americanize many breeds, and the general dog scene maybe a bit too professional to my liking. I am, however, very happy to say, not so with the corgis. Maybe you like them a shade longer in body, but construction, movement and condition both with muscle and coat is generally excellent. I am a bit of a head freak myself, and even though dogs do not work with a pretty expression, it certainly adds that little extra to the overall picture. Also in this respect I found your dogs better than most places, though many different types and

quite a few prominent eyes. Long bodies and short ribcages make a weakness, and I would be aware of this problem creeping into our breed as in many others. I found some lovely winners in all my classes, and it is a joy to judge when the dogs are presented in such an excellent manner, and the ring steward keeps an excellent order all the time. Slightly curved over the loin. Excellent hind angulations. Good bone for size. Not in best coat condition. Moves well sideways.

Masculine, but slightly strong head. Good reach of neck but slightly off balanced front and rear. Steep croup and needs more rear angulations. Moves quite well but should have better hind action.

Another excellent dog with good proportions. Strong dog with nice head but needs slightly more width of skull. Excellent neck and topline. Good angulations. Good brisket. Sufficient bone for size. Tends to fall a bit on his front when moving. Excellent coat.
4. **CAAMORA MARTY GRAW** (Ch. Tallyrand No Greater Love x Ch. Caamora Paper Doll) Breeders: Patricia Seifert & Vicki Kirsher. Owners: Patricia & Dennis Seifert. Very nice dog. Good size. Prefer slightly longer lines. Nice head, but a little wide set ears and a bit prominent eyes. Prefer slightly more reach of neck and angulations in front. Good brisket. Good bone and feet. Good hind angulations. Needs better front reach.

Movement very loose coming and going and needs to stabilize his sidegait. Excellent coat.
